This strange looking machine pictured above is our new project for Mount Calvary Baptist Camp. This is a **Hyundai generator** with approximately 44 KVA's of power. The generator we now have was bought in the summer **of 1992.** It has provided electricity for the camp for **20 years**, but during the past couple of years it has begun to fail. Twice during the camps this summer a mechanic had to come out and repair it. The generator in the picture is smaller but more than sufficient for the needs at camp. This new one can be purchased here in Guadalajara.

So now, the question is: **How much is this going to cost?** The total price including bringing it to the camp and setting it up is **9,310,95€** which translated into \$'s right now would be approximately **\$9,193.00**. We have an excellent exchange rate now (almost 1 to 1). The Spanish churches who support camp on a monthly basis have already begun to commit themselves, but it is almost an impossible task for them to pay it all. The churches are basically small and our inflation rate now is worse than the U.S.A. Gas costs **8 euros a gallon!**

So we appeal to you, our supporting churches and friends to **partner with us** for this new project. Any amount would be tremendously appreciated. Camp is being blessed and used by God. The above picture was taken this past Saturday. It was a regional youth meeting organized by our church in Guadalajara. There were 132 present, 90% young people. They love camp and basically came together for the last time this year before the cold weather sets in until camps begin this next summer - hopefully with a **new generator**. Can you help make this possible?
